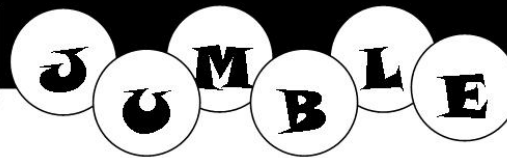

Often referred to as charitable aid or donations, this act of gift giving by alumni, friends and corporations and foundations, is a major form of financial support for Penn State students, faculty and programs.

P H I L A N T H R O P Y

1. Later funding the construction of the Alumni Center, their first gift was a \$2.00 contribution to Athletics.
2. Working at Penn State since 1950, this coach and his wife, Sue, donated over \$4 million dollars and helped raise \$13.5 million more for the renovation of the Library named in their honor.
3. Their first contribution was a \$10 gift to the College of Liberal Arts in 1960. They later contributed \$30 million to create Penn State's Honors College.
4. Responsible for the University's largest single donation to the College of Business, their first gift to Penn State was a \$5.00 contribution to the College of Liberal Arts in 1953.
5. Given in 1861, the first class gift was a portrait of this man, Penn State's first president. The portrait still hangs in the lobby of Old Main.
