Areas that can Benefit from Your Gifts

Unrestricted gifts

Unrestricted gifts, those not donor-designated for a specific use, are especially important to Penn State. They broaden the scope of program enrichment by enabling the University to provide funds where the need is greatest.

College and Campus Programs

Opportunities for giving are plentiful at all Penn State locations. All recognized programs, research projects, and activities can be measurably helped by faculty and staff support.

Trustee Scholarship Program

Each undergraduate college and campus has a general Trustee Scholarship Fund. The University will match 5 percent of gifts made in support of these scholarships at the campus or college of the donor's choice. Undergraduate and Graduate Student Support

Many talented students have received exceptional educational opportunities as a result of Penn State's commitment to providing outstanding educational programs at costs that are accessible to all students, regardless of their financial means. Renaissance Fund, College, or Campus scholarships and other resources for undergraduate and graduate students, provided by your gifts, enhance the quality and accessibility of a Penn State education.

Faculty Support

Support of Penn State faculty and faculty programs include giving to a dean's chair, department head's chair, faculty chair, faculty fellowships, or professorship awards.

Penn State College of Medicine/Penn State Hershey Medical Center

There are many opportunities for support including gifts to the Penn State Children's Hospital, Penn State Cancer Institute, Penn State College of Medicine Endowed Scholarship Fund, and the Penn State Hershey Medical Center General Research Fund.

University Libraries

Gifts enable purchases of books and journals, various types of technology information resources, and the preservation of collections.

Intercollegiate Athletics

Gifts support more than 800 student-athletes on 29 men's and women's varsity sports teams. By joining the Nittany Lion Club you support athletic scholarships. Penn State Athletics receives no state or university funding to operate the program.

WPSU

Membership gifts support the programs and services these public broadcasting stations provide to Penn State and central Pennsylvania.

Shaver's Creek Environmental Center

As Penn State's nature center, Shaver's Creek reaches thousands of people annually through traveling animal programs, field trips for school groups, public nature programs, and by teaching more than 30 university courses. Gifts support the care of injured and non-releasable hawks and owls at the Raptor Center, program scholarships for youth, college internships and landscape stewardship.

Arts Programs

Contributions may be made to the Center for the Performing Arts, Palmer Museum of Art, Pennsylvania Centre Stage, and many other programs in the arts including the Blue Band, which qualifies donors to be members of the Floating Lions Club.

Employee Assistance Fund (EAP)

Gifts to this fund will provide financial support for faculty and staff facing a wide range of personal or family hardships. The fund enhances the quality of life and improves the mental, emotional and physical well-being of employees and members of their household during difficult circumstances.

The Arboretum at Penn State

A gift to the Arboretum will help Penn State to build one of the nation's finest university arboreta. When completed, the Arboretum will feature over 50 acres of cultivated gardens, a conservatory, and an education center next to Park Avenue, and encompass more than 300 acres of restored woodlands.

Recognition Societies

The President's Club

Join Penn State donors who make unrestricted gifts each year of \$2,500 or more to either the Penn State Future Fund or the Future Fund for a College or Campus. This can be accomplished with a payroll deduction of \$209 per month.
